B: Bitola (Macedonian: Битола, formerly Monastir or Manastir; known also by several alternative names) is a city in the south-western part of the Republic of Macedonia. The city is an administrative, cultural, industrial, commercial, and educational centre. It is located in the southern part of the Pelagonia valley, surrounded by the Baba and Nidže mountains, 14 km north of the Medžitlija-Níki border crossing with Greece. It is an important junction connecting the south of the Adriatic Sea with the Aegean Sea and Central Europe. It is known from the Ottoman period as "the city of the consuls", as many European countries have consulates in Bitola. Bitola is the second largest town in the country and is also the centre of the Bitola Municipality.

This year Bitola Open City Festival will have ninth edition and will be full of happenings like rock concert as the highlight of the gathering, graffiti gallery, rollerblading competition, street theatre, workshops, jam sessions evenings...
