The main goal of the work camp is to promote a social and communitary campaign, which name is “Helping Hands”, in collaboration with other Cucujães´ entities, in order to develop the intervention and participation of the youth in society. The participants will do many cleaning actions in gardens and public spaces of the village, roundabouts and monuments; they will give support to the Cucujães´ Library activity as well as to two Day-Centres, devoted to the elderly population. During the workcamp, all participants will have to prepare some meals, helped by a cook, and clean the camp. There will be a day dedicated to each participant’s country, in which they will have the opportunity to promote their country through food and other activities. Sportive and cultural activities will take place involving the camp’ participants and other local young. The purpose is to promote the exchange of experiences and knowledge about the history and the culture of each country or region, having in mind an intercultural approach. They will have the opportunity to visit cities, mountains and beaches, such as Porto, Aveiro, Serra da Freita, Espinho and Furadouro.

This association has been organizing throughout the years a series of activities, namely: Exchanges – Youth and Palops; National and International Work Camps; Holiday Centers and Camps; Sportive Holidays; Holidays in Movement; PAAJ since 1996; among other permanent activities, such as: Group of Dances and Folklore, Sport Schools, etc.

Visit to FATACIL – Lagoa, Mediaeval Days of Castro Marim, visit to an aquatic park, visits to leisure places (Albufeira, Lagos, Faro e Tavira). In Pechão sport zone we will perform several games, such as football, basketball, handball, volleyball, tennis and others, whenever time permits and participants feel like.
